**PURPOSE:** These step by step instructions CD for making paper windmills will encourage children to learn the principle of windmills as science, as well as to have fun by playing with windmills as a toy. Children and their parents will be able to get this CD at a hobby section in a craft store with a hobby book.

**INTERFACES: STEPS:**

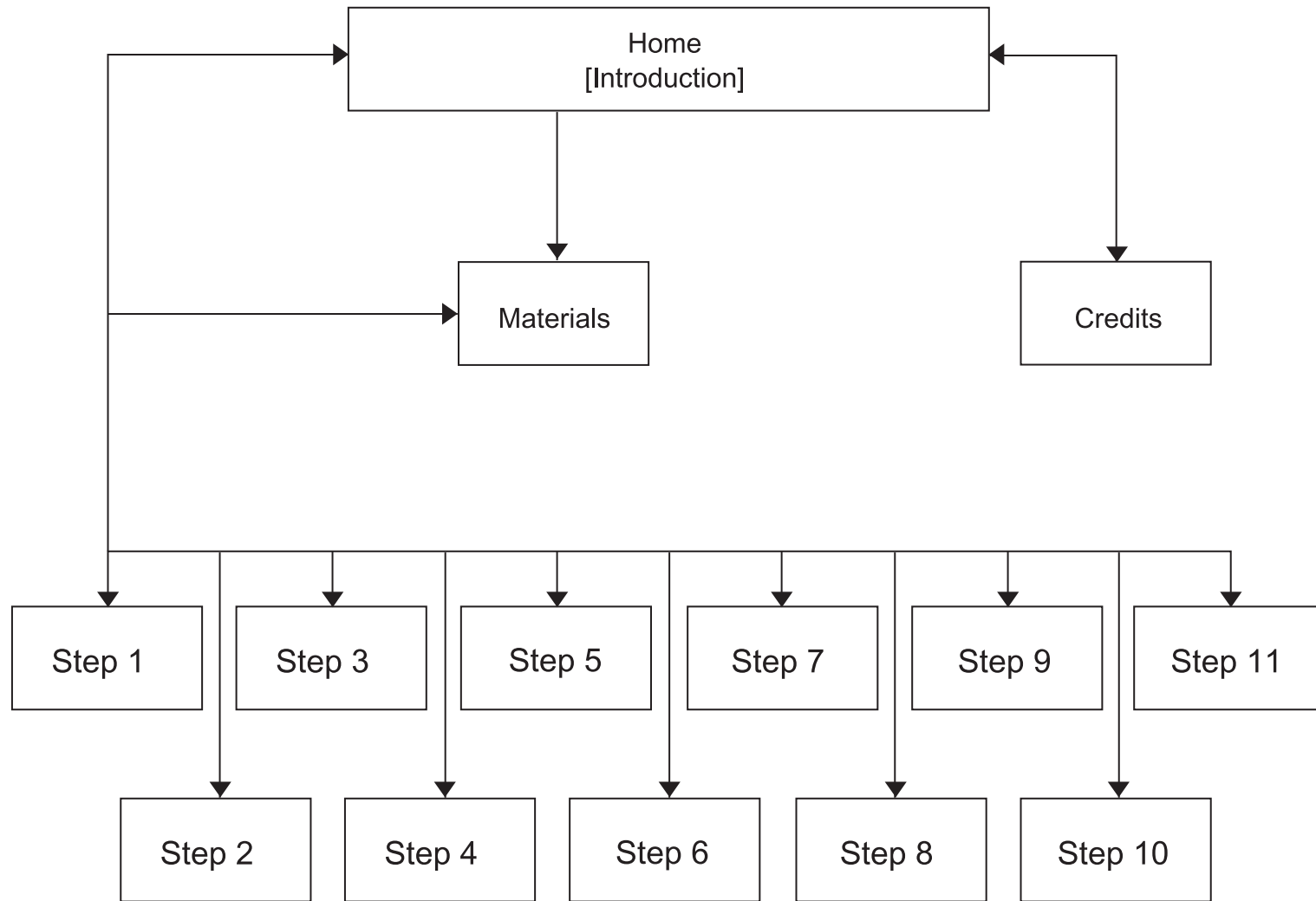
Introduction: These step by step instructions on how to make paper windmills will encourage children to learn the principle of windmills as a science, as well as to have fun by playing with windmills as a toy.

Materials: Paper (letter size), thin sticks (12 inches), pins, crayons, and scissors.

1. Cut the paper into an 8" square.
2. Fold the square corner to corner in half diagonally.
3. Fold it again.
4. Open the paper and lay it out flat. (It will have an "x" creased through it.)
5. Color in or decorate both sides of the paper.
6. Cut along each fold to within one inch of the center.
7. Pick up one corner and hold it in the center.
8. Pick up each corner and hold it in the center again.
9. Keep the corners in the center by sticking a straight pin through them.
10. Secure the windmill to the wooden dowel or handle with the pin.
11. Move the windmill through the air and watch it spin.

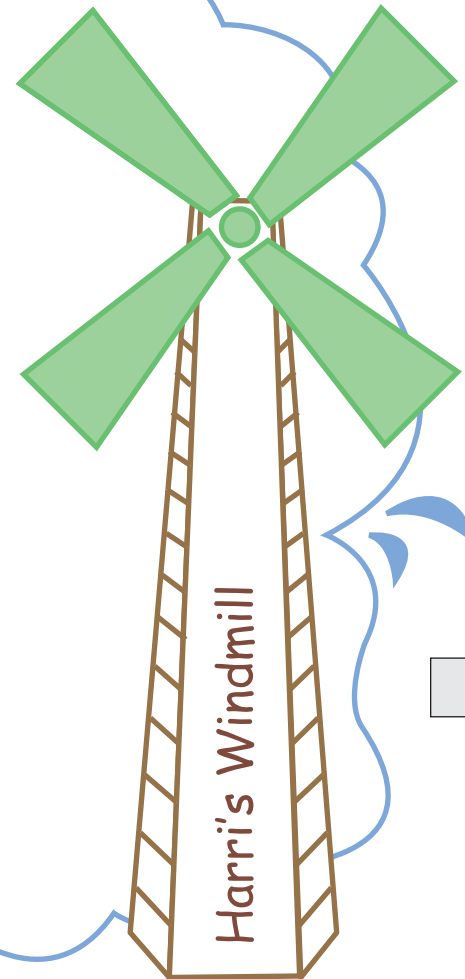
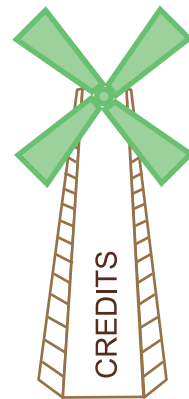

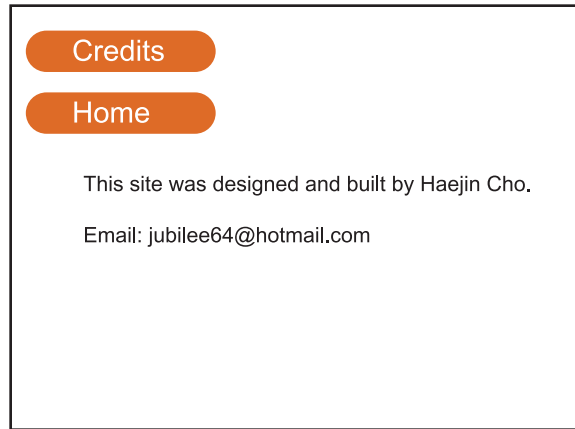

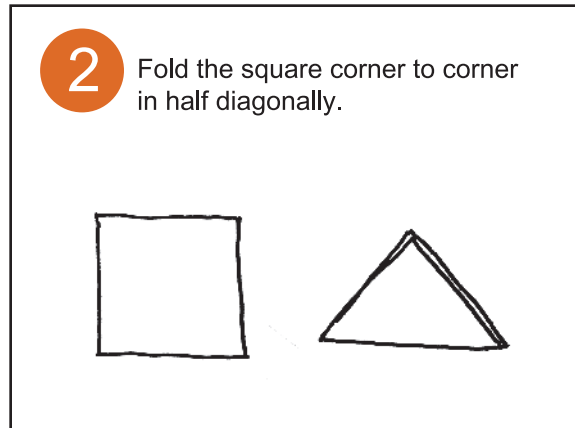

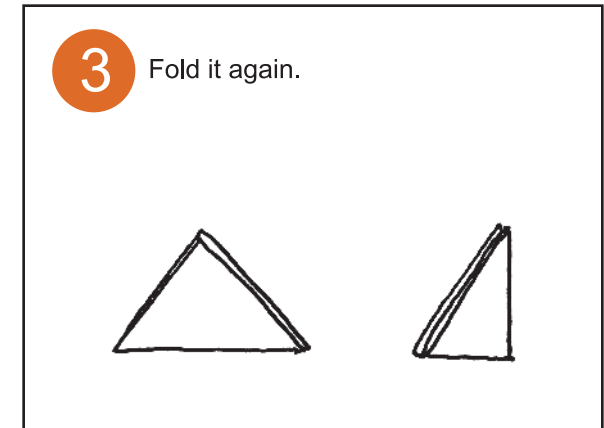
1. Each material is flying in and positioning.



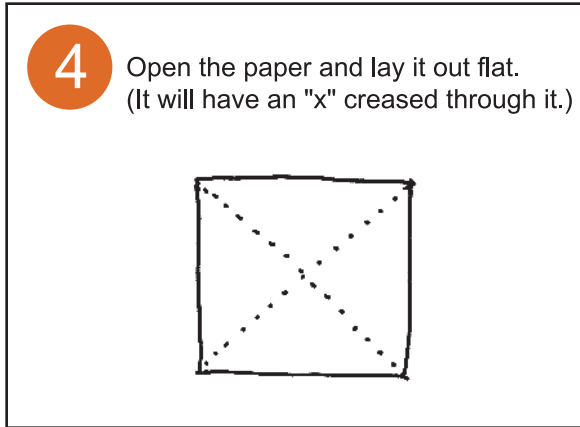
1. A sheet of 8 x 11" paper is flying in.

1. The square is being folded corner to corner in half diagonally.

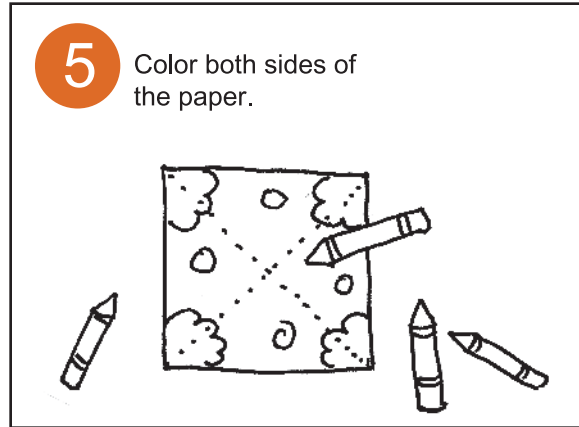


1. The folded square is being folded again.



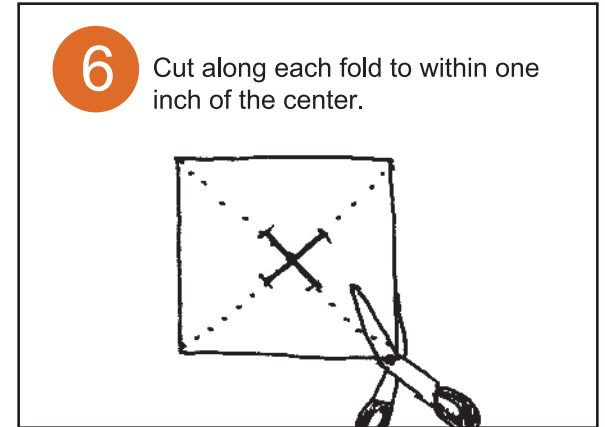
**4** Open the paper and lay it out flat. (It will have an "x" creased through it.)

1. The paper is being open and laid out flat.



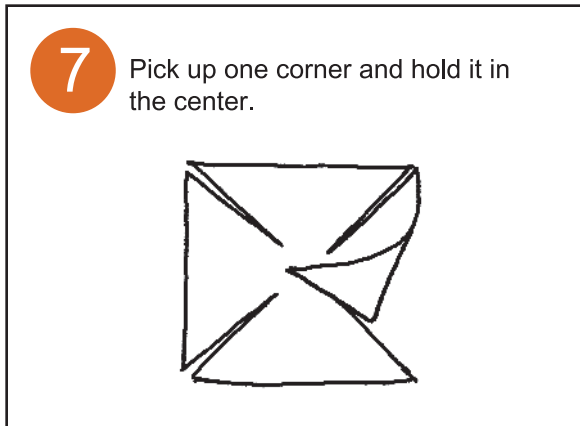
**5** Color both sides of the paper.

1. Crayons are flying in and a crayon is drawing and coloring on the paper.



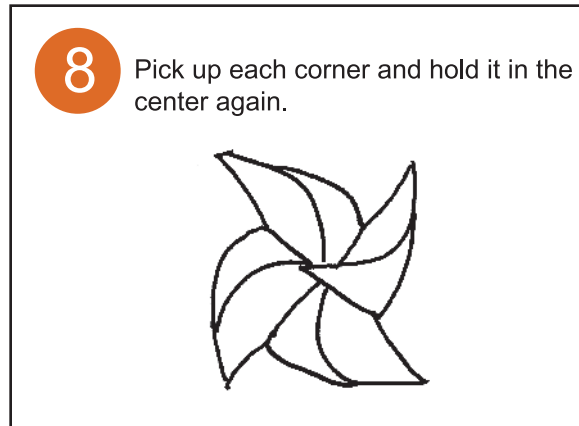
**6** Cut along each fold to within one inch of the center.

1. Scissors are flying in and cutting along each fold to within one inch of the center.



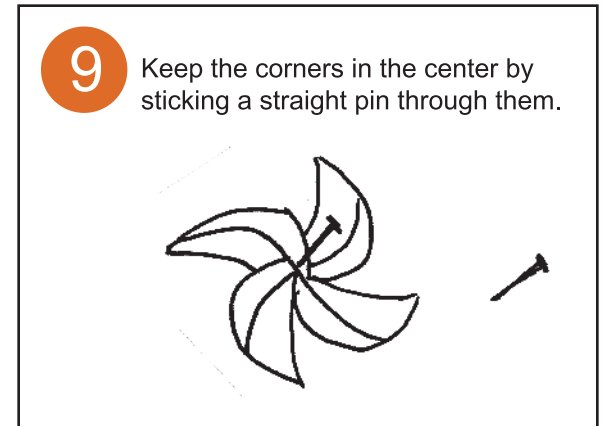
**7** Pick up one corner and hold it in the center.

2. A warning message, "This step requires adults' guide", is appearing.

Secure the windmill to the wooden dowel or handle with the pin.



1. A handle stick is flying in.
2. The paper windmill is being secured to the dowel or handle with the pin.
3. A message saying "Now you got the windmill." is appearing.

Move the windmill through the air and watch it spin.



1. Two children are appearing with the paper windmill in their hands.
2. Air is blowing from the left.
3. The children are moving the windmill through the air.
